Minutes of an Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held at the Parish Hall, St Brelade on Tuesday 25 August 2020 commencing at 19:00 hours.

President of Assembly:

Convening Notice:

The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary.

1. Minutes of Previous Assembly:

The minutes of the previous Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held on 4 August 2020, were adopted, and signed following a proposition by Procureur Peter Norman, which was seconded by Deputy Graham Truscott.

2. Licensing:
