

**PARISH OF ST BRELADE**

**PARISH ASSEMBLY**

Minutes of an Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held in the Main Hall at the Parish Hall, St Aubin, St Brelade on Tuesday 25 January 2022 commencing at 19:00 hours.

<b><u>President of Assembly:</u></b>	Connétable, Mr Michael Jackson, presided.
<b><u>Convening Notice:</u></b>	The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary.
<b>1. <u>Minutes of Previous Assembly :</u></b>	The minutes of the previous Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held on Tuesday 30 November 2021 were adopted and signed following a proposition by Chef de Police Michel Bougeard, which was seconded by Mr Michael Videgrain. The Connétable asked for a show of hands with all those in favour, the Minutes were approved unanimously.
<b>2. <u>Elect one Officier du Connétable for the Vingtaine de Noirmont:</u></b>	The Connétable addressed the meeting and asked if there were any nominees for the office of an Officier du Connétable for the Vingtaine de Noirmont. Centenier Amanda Wright nominated Miss Phillipa Wright, her daughter. Miss Wright had been schooled in both Jersey and the UK and studied both Criminal Justice and Politics at Plymouth University, she had worked for Customs and Excise in the UK. Centenier Wright went on to say that Miss Wright would be a huge asset to the Honorary Police and the Parish. The Connétable thanked Centenier Wright for the nomination and asked if this was seconded. Officier du Connétable Ian Wright (CO Wright) then seconded the nomination. CO Wright also acknowledged that Miss Wright is his daughter and reiterated what Centenier Wright had said in her nomination speech also adding that Miss Wright was very keen to work within the Honorary Police. The Connétable thanked CO Wright and asked if there were more nominations. There being none forthcoming, the Connétable declared Miss Wright duly elected and thanked her for taking on this role and advised her to attend the Royal Court on Friday 28 January 2022 to take the oath of office at 10.00 a.m..
<b>3. <u>To elect one Road Inspector for the Vingtaine des Quennevais to complete</u></b>	The Connétable invited nominations for a Road Inspector for the Vingtaine des Quennevais to complete the terms of office of the late Mr Brian de ste Croix. The Chef de Police, Michel Bougeard nominated, Mr Paul Beaugié

Centenier Bougeard advised the meeting that he had known Mr Beaugié for 38 years as they both worked as Conveyancers. He added that Mr Beaugié's conveyancing knowledge will certainly be a big asset to the Parish. The Connétable thanked Centenier Bougeard and asked if there was a seconder for the nomination. Mr Michael Videgrain seconded the nomination. Mr Videgrain added that he had worked with Mr Beaugié during his time as the Parish Secretary on many issues as Mr Beaugié works for the Parish's legal advisers.</p> <p>The Connétable asked if there were any more nominations. There being none, he declared Mr Beaugié duly elected and warned him to attend the Royal Court to take the oath of office on Friday morning at 10.00 a.m. He thanked Mr Beaugié for standing and reiterated Centenier Bougeard words saying that his conveyancing knowledge would certainly assist during the Visites du Branchages.</p>
