This guide explains how to use the St. Brelade household recycling collection. A collection planner is included so you know when your recycling will be collected.

Every home in St. Brelade receives a recycling collection, in addition to the existing rubbish and glass collections. Recycling collections will be on the same day as your general refuse is collected.
