PARISH ASSEMBLY

	Minutes of an Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held at St Brelade's Parish Hall on Tuesday 29 August 2023 commencing at 19:00 hours.
President of Assembly:	Connétable Mr M K Jackson, presided.
Convening Notice:	The Convening Notice was read by Connétable M K Jackson.
1. Minutes of Previous Assembly:	The Minutes of the previous Assembly of Principals and Electors of The Parish of St Brelade held on 25 July 2023, were read by Connétable M K Jackson and adopted following a proposal by Mr Alan Breckon which was seconded by Mr Chris Cooke with all in favour.
2. Tres D'Or Limited application for recommendation to the Licensing Assembly for 1st Category (Taverners) License:	<p>The application was proposed by Mr Christian Sufer and seconded by Mr Marin Sorin. The Chairman invited the Company Secretary Mr Alexandru Milosescu to address the Assembly. Mr Milosescu explained he currently held a 3rd Category Licence at present and a 1st Category Licences would enable the business to provide a better service including buffets/small parties for events such as weddings, christenings and interactive experiences such as cocktail master classes which was currently not possible with a table only service.</p> <p>Following questions from the Assembly Mr Milosescu confirmed any occasional live music would be inside the premises only and security would be provided if necessary to ensure noise was kept to a minimum and all safety regulations would be met regarding numbers and access.</p> <p>In response to questions from the Assembly regarding noise from the extractor fan, Mr Milosescu confirmed the steps previously undertaken to reduce noise nuisance had not been successful and he was currently awaiting the arrival of equipment from the UK for engineers to rectify the problem.</p> <p>Following extensive discussion it was suggested by the Chairman that Mr Milosescu temporarily withdraw the application until further details could be made available to the Assembly and representation from Mr Milosescu's Lawyer could be arranged. This was agreed by Mr Milosescu and the item was withdrawn.</p>
3. Victoria Garages Limited (Falles Petrol Station) re 6th Category (off	The application to consider a 6 th Category (off licence) Liquor Licence to sell alcohol from premises through an on-line platform (website) was proposed by Mr Steven Bressat and seconded by Mr Elvis Romeril.

<p>licence) Liquor Licence</p>	<p>The Chairman invited Advocate Michelle Leverington to address the Assembly as a representative of the applicant.</p> <p>Advocate Leverington stated the licence was required in order to sell goods and alcohol which are currently available in store, through an on-line platform and that the Royal Court had advised this be considered through a Parish Assembly. Delivery drivers would be trained and the business would run in the same way as many other on-line stores currently run.</p> <p>There were no questions from the Assembly who voted 21 in favour and none against.</p> <p>The application was therefore approved.</p>
<p>4. St Brelade's Bay Hotel re 4th Category Liquor Licence to extend their licence to cover an external area in front of the Hotel.</p>	<p>The application to consider a 4th Category Liquor Licences to cover an external area in front of the Hotel was proposed by Ms Jane Patterson and seconded by Mr Roy Fairweather.</p> <p>The Chairman invited Ms Jane Patterson to address the Assembly.</p> <p>Ms Patterson stated the application was to enable use of an area of land opposite the Hotel to be used on occasions for wine tasting and similar events. This would only be for the use of Hotel guests and any mess would be dealt with by hotel staff who would also ensure safe crossing of the road.</p> <p>Discussions were in place to consider the placement of a zebra crossing.</p> <p>A vote was taken with 21 in favour of the application and none against.</p> <p>The application was therefore approved.</p>
