President of Assembly:	Connétable Mr M K Jackson, presided.	
Convening Notice:	The Convening Notice was read by the Assistant Parish Secretary.	
1. Minutes of Previous Assembly:	The Minutes of the previous Assembly of Principals and Electors of The Parish of St Brelade held on 26 September 2023 were read by Connétable M K Jackson and adopted following a proposal by Centenier Michel Bougeard which was seconded by Deputy Moz Scott with all in favour.	
2. Elect one Officier du Connétable for the Vingtaine des Quennevais:	The Connétable called for nominations to fill the position of Officier du Connétable for the Vingtaine des Quennevais for a term of three years.	
	Centenier Michel Bougeard proposed Mr Paul Piggott for election. This nomination was seconded by Centenier Amanda Wright. Both addressed the Assembly confirming they were delighted Mr Piggott was standing for a further term of office as a valuable member of the Honorary Police.	
	The Connétable congratulated Mr Piggott and declared him duly elected as an Officier du Connétable for a three-year term, warning him to appear before the Royal Court of Jersey on Friday 3 November 2023 at 10.00 hours prompt to take the Oath of Office.	
3. Vote a sum not to exceed £10,000 from equipment reserve account in order to purchase computer equipment and hardware equipment for Parish main office:	Consideration was given to vote a sum not to exceed the amount of £10,000 from the Office Equipment Reserve Fund for IT replacements to all areas of the Parish Hall.	
	The Chairman advised the Assembly that IT needed to be updated or replaced on a regular basis. Deputy Moz Scott questioned who the provider was and how old the computers were and enquired if this had been put out to tender. Following general discussion, it was agreed that the Procureur du Bien Public would examine the quotes.	
	Mr Michael Videgrain proposed the purchase of computers subject to the approval from the Procureurs.	
	Deputy Moz Scott seconded the proposal which was carried by 12 votes in favour with no members of the Assembly against.
