DINGHY PONTOON INSPECTION

Dear Boatowner:

The Northern dinghy pontoon on the South Pier (The pontoon which houses dinghies with outboard engines) is due to be removed from service to permit for structural inspection and decking replacement, this coming March

This will necessitate the pontoon being lifted out of the harbour and placed onto the South Pier arm, whilst maintenance works are undertaken

Boat owners with dinghies currently located on this pontoon are requested to please ensure their dinghies are vacated from the pontoon by no later than Sunday 10th March, in order to allow for these necessary works to be undertaken without undue hinderance

Whilst we appreciate the inconvenience this may pose to some boat owners, with moorings in the immediate vicinity; these works are necessary in order to ensure the pontoon can be serviced to allow for its continued use and extend its serviceable life

We will be working with the Boat Owners Association to assist in identifying alternative locations for the displaced dinghies to be located during these works
