1. Minutes of Previous Assembly:	The Minutes of the previous Assembly of Principals and Electors of The Parish of St Brelade held on 28 May 2024, were adopted and signed following a proposal by Mr Michael Videgrain which was seconded by Mr Antony Bellows with all in favour, subject to Item 3 which had changed from the original document, which will now read as follows:		
	"Mr Michael Videgrain questioned the make-up of the total amount of £415,000 and considered that the total cost was of a capital nature and should therefore come out of the Property Reserve Fund.		
	Mr Michael Videgrain formally proposed that the sum not exceeding £415,000 to cover the re roofing of the Parish Hall including scaffolding from the Property Reserve Fund, subject to £35,000 being transferred from the General Account to the Property Reserve Fund at the July 2024 Parish Assembly. The proposition was seconded by Mr Stephen Pallett and carried by 40 voters in favour with no member of the Assembly voting against."

	The Connétable read the Fire and Morris Architects Report to the Assembly. Occupancy was agreed at 110 persons downstairs and 110 persons upstairs and that the toilet		

provisions were satisfactory. The premises were deemed suitable for the purpose, providing existing safety measures and precautions were continued to be maintained at their current standard. The Connétable invited Mrs Michelle Cabot from Viberts to address the Assembly, there would be no changes to the opening hours. Clarification was to be sought that building control had issued their completion permit. Centanier Bougeard raised his concerns about playing music and requested that this would not be audible from the beach area. The Connétable asked for any further questions.

The Connétable asked for a proposer and seconder, Mr Eddie Burns proposed and was seconded by Mrs Claire Burns.

There being no further questions a vote was taken with 18 in favour and none against.

 Elect one Officier du Connétable for the Vingtaine de Noirmont: The Connétable called for nominations to fill the position of Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine du Noirmont for a term of three years.

Centenier Michel Bougeard proposed Mr John Holloway for election. This was seconded by Vingtenier Jane Drew. There were no other nominations.

Centenier Michel Bougeard and Vingtenier Jane Drew declared they had no hesitation in nominating Mr Holloway, he was an exemplary officer. He was 100% committed, a stickler for detail and a great team player.

The Connétable declared Mr Holloway duly elected as Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine du Noirmont for a term of three years. The Connétable congratulated Mr Holloway and advised him to appear before the Royal Court of Jersey to take the Oath of Office at 10 am on Friday 5 July 2024.

4. Consider a recommendation of the Road's Committee that the Parish accept the gift of a section of Les Landes Avenue adjacent to Mont Nicolle presently

The Connétable referred to a map on display of land that was owned by the late Jurat Vibert and was now inherited by his son who did not live locally and did not want the responsibility of maintaining it and offered it to the Parish along with a sum of money of £20,000..

Mr Stephen Pallett questioned if £20,000 was for the full amount. The Connétable replied that the full cost was £35,000 and advised that non acceptance would lead to further deterioration.
