Minutes of an Assembly of Electors of the Parish of St Brelade held at the Parish Hall, St Aubin on Tuesday 3 February 2026 commencing at 19.00 hours respectively for the following business.

President of the Assembly:

Convening Notice:

The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary.

Election of Centenier:

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 9 January 2026 and in accordance with Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law, 2002. The Assembly was held to proceed with the election of one Centenier, the term of office of Raoul Sanders Gear being due to expire by virtue of the provisions of Article 1 of the Centeniers (Terms of Office) (Jersey) Law 2007, the said 11 March 2026 being the next appointed day referred to in Article 2 of the said Law.

The Connétable called for nominations to fill the office of Centenier for the next three years.
