He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!"

Revelation Chapter 21 verse 5

Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed. Alleluia!

Our Eastertide celebrations continue this month as we rejoice in Christ's work of salvation for us and for the whole world by his death, resurrection, ascension and exaltation.

Ascension Day falls on Thursday 14th May and we will reflect on this theme in our short service at 12 noon, following our coffee morning.

On Pentecost Sunday 24th May we shall gather with our wider Methodist family for morning worship led by myself at Bethlehem Methodist Church in St. Mary's at 10.30am.

You are warmly invited to join us for these services. For those first followers of Jesus, Easter brought with it a new day, a new understanding of Jesus, it gave them new courage and new life.

But Easter did not mean that the journey ahead would be without its difficulties and hostilities for those first Christians. They would face scorn, opposition and persecution.

But at Pentecost they had the promise of Christ's living presence and the promise of the Holy Spirit coming to help them. They were confident in Christ's final victory.

In our own difficulties, when our walk with God is uphill, we pause to look again at the empty cross and the empty tomb. We remember the immense love Jesus has for us and for our world and we are encouraged and heartened. We take the next step of faith.

We open ourselves to a new work of God within us and among us.

The Holy Spirit is our Counsellor and our Guide. Christ is making all things new, including you and me.
